The games will last from February 19th until the 26th. Obihiro will host speedskating races from February 20th until the 23rd. All of the events in Obihiro are FREE, so please feel free to watch the

best and fastest speed-skaters from all over Asia!

Obihiro is home to the newest of two permanent indoor speed-skating rinks in Japan, the Meiji Hokkaido Tokachi Oval 明治北海道十勝オーバル (the other rink is located in Nagano). Being less than 10 years old, hosting the 2017 Asian Winter Games will be the Oval's largest event yet.

Culture: Valentine's Day in Japan

This month, American CIR, Elaine, chimes in to talk about Valentine's Day in Japan and how it differs from what she experienced back home in the states.

The origins of Valentine's Day isn't clear, but it is generally agreed that its namesake is of a saint named Valentine (there are multiple "Saint Valentines") and that it is rooted in Christianity. In both the west and Japan, Valentine's Day has very much become a holiday for lovers, friends and sweets!

Only Women?

Hands down, the most noticeable difference between Valentine's Day in Japan and America is that in Japan only women give gifts.

Most readers have probably heard of "White Day" which occurs 1 month after Valentine's Day when men who have received gifts on February 14th reciprocate with white-colored gifts on March 14th.

Traditionally, couples in America give

And everyone else gets 義理チョコ giri choko or "obligatory chocolate," which are given because they have to be!
