Getting the Right Information: Disaster Information

Last month the Iburi sub-prefecture experienced a magnitude 6.7 earthquake, leading to a massive power outage across Hokkaido. While most parts of Hokkaido, including Tokachi, are returning to their normal lives, this has also been a learning experience for the next disaster. In this month's Obihiro Pioneer, we will introduce how one can find the right information in the wake of a disaster.

Time is of the Essence

Getting information before it's too late can make all the difference. Most Japanese phones are automatically set up to have push-alerts in emergency/disaster situation. Check your settings for "Emergency Alerts" or 緊急連絡 き んきゅうれんらく and make sure it is turned on. Phones without this option can download various applications for disaster information. The Japan Tourism Agency launched the application "Safety Tips" for free. "Safety Tips" is aimed at international visitors to Japan and



provides up-to-date info in 5 languages.

Local Information

For more relevant information, look locally. Most city/town halls have homepages online and will list the most up-to-date information for its residents. Obihiro City has a homepage and an official Facebook page, which both posts the same information in the event of a disaster.
