Valentine's Day in Japan 日本のバレンタインデー

Valentine's Day is widely celebrated in Japan on the 14th of February. In western countries, Valentine's Day is a time when both men and women buy gifts for their partners or treat them to a romantic meal etc., but Japan has created its own tradition that's a little bit different. In Japan, Valentine's Day is when women give chocolate to the people around them. This chocolate can be split into roughly three categories:

Giri-choco 義理チョコ

This is chocolate that's required to be given to colleagues, though it's also often given to family or even exchanged between students and teachers. It's regarded as a token of thanks or appreciation, and is usually something small and somewhat inexpensive.

Tomo-choco 友チョコ

Lately it has become popular among Japanese women to give chocolate to their friends whom they love in a non-romantic way. While this kind of chocolate is probably nicer than giri-choco, it still pales in comparison to.....

Honmei-choco 本命チョコ

This is chocolate given to your "special someone" with the intent of conveying your feelings towards them. This chocolate is usually somewhat more expensive and extravagant, or may even possibly be homemade.

So does this mean that men get lots of chocolate and have to do nothing in return? Not quite!

While men get a free

pass for Valentine's Day, men are expected to return the favor and give chocolate to all those they received chocolate from on the 14th March, which is called "White Day". 
