## A Fake Backpacker's Journey: Hanoi, Vietnam

*It's finally back! The last we heard from CIR "Gan-Chan" about her backpacking trip around southeast Asia, she was in Laos*



*riding elephants. With elephant license in hand, let's follow Gan-Chan onto the next leg of her journey: Hanoi, Vietnam.*

After an hour-long flight from Luang Prabang to Hanoi International Airport on Vietnam Airlines, we arrived into Hanoi around 8 at night without plans for the next day. We booked a hostel on Old Quarter Street and decided to stop by a travel agency to book a day trip to Halong Bay before checking in. Unable to settle on a fair price, we ended up leaving the travel agency around 10 pm. Our first meal in Hanoi was sticky rice with fried meat from a street vendor.

Even late at night, many young people and foreigners could be



seen sitting on small chairs and low tables on sidewalks, drinking and talking. We found our hostel after wandering around for about an hour. The front gate was closed because it was late, so we tried knocking on the

rolling steel door before eventually calling the booking company to have a staff member open the door.

We booked 4 beds in a mix dormitory room. There were 8 bunk beds in the room with air conditions free wifi service, but there were only 4 of us on that floor. The shower rooms and toilets were clean and new, but the room and beds were a bit old. To tell you the truth, I didn't like the room. It was scary. We paid just about 400Y each for one night and I booked it myself, so I couldn't complain!

One long night at the scary hostel passed, and morning came. I got up early and was so excited to explore Hanoi.

After we checked out, we started the day by grabbing “Bánh canh,” a thick Vietnamese soup noodle dish for breakfast. It cost just 30,000 Vietnamese Dong (around 150 Yen) for



1 bowl and it was good! Before I came to Hanoi, I thought there were many bikes and cars on the road in Thailand, but it

pales in comparison to Hanoi! After breakfast, we walked around; visiting 2 famous temples in Hanoi, Ngoc Son temple and Bach Ma temple. Then we had lunch and Vietnamese coffee at a nearby café. And walked again, visiting

Tran Quoc Pagoda. In the evening, we found a group of teenagers playing soccer at Lenin Park. Since our 2 male members were soccer lovers, they asked to join the fun, while the girls took a break.



Our day in Hanoi ended with spring rolls and Hanoi beers at a restaurant on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of a building downtown. After dinner, we gathered our things and caught a taxi to Hanoi station, to board the next train to Dong Hoi.
